

Gospel of John with Msgr. John

On Thursdays throughout Lent, (March 2nd through April 6th), Msgr. John will offer an Introduction to the Gospel of John from 6:30 to 8 p.m. in St. Ann's Family Center.

The Gospel of John plays a major role in the readings at Mass during the Lenten season. This introduction should provide you with a means of searching deeper into the readings.

The Gospel of John is different from the other gospels in tone, in text and in theology. It is a very poetic gospel, which can make it difficult to approach.

To a greater degree than the other gospels, John's Gospel records the struggles of that early community. In many ways their struggle matches ours today.

Along the way we will take some time to show how biblical scholars work and the methods and tools they use to study the scriptures.

No prior bible study classes are necessary. Just bring your interest. There are no books or fees required for this seminar. All are welcome.

Lenten Regulations

- 1. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. Two meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- 2. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- 3. The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age.
- 4. The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age,
- 5. Although the faithful may excuse themselves *for a just cause* from these laws of fast and abstinence, there is an obligation to *substitute another penance* and no Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from this obligation in the Lenten season.
