Short Excerpts Taken from Pope Francis' Addresses And Homilies "We Are Not Part-Time Christians"

Let us ask ourselves . . . What steps we are taking to ensure that faith governs the whole of our existence. We are not Christians "part-time," only at certain moments, in certain circumstances, in certain decisions; no one can be Christian in this way. We are Christian all the time! Totally! May Christ's truth, which the Holy Spirit Teaches us and gives to us, always and totally affect our daily life. Let us call on him more often so that he may guide us on the path of disciples of Christ. Let us call on him every day.
