

# Short Excerpts Taken from Pope Francis' Addresses And Homilies "Are We Living Stones?"

How do we live our being Church? Are we living stones, or are we, as it were, stones that are weary, bored, or indifferent? Have you ever noticed how grim it is to see a tired, bored, and indifferent Christian? A Christian like that is all wrong; the Christian must be alive, rejoicing in being Christian; he or she must live this beauty of belonging to the People of God which is the Church. Do we open ourselves to the action of the Holy Spirit, to be an active part of our communities, or do we withdraw into ourselves, saying, "I have so much to do; it isn't my job!"?

The Lord gives all of us his grace, his strength, so that we may be profoundly united to Christ, who is the cornerstone, the pillar and the foundation of our life and of the whole life of the Church. Let us pray that enlivened by his Spirit, we may always be living stones of His Church.
