**From Our Parish Nurse:** Summer is here and we will all be spending a lot of time outdoors. With this in mind, here are a few tips to maximize your health and wellbeing.

**Furnace Update:** This past week, a representative from Robert W. Hall Consulting Engineers Inc., of Agawam, began a comprehensive study of our heating system here in the church.

Among the recommendations they will make to us is whether we should continue with steam heat, or convert over to hot water. Once this study is complete, we will begin the process of getting bids from local contactors to update our heating system.

Along with our heating system update, we will also be addressing the asbestos found in our church basement and how best to secure it for future generations.
