### The Holy Day of All Saints is Coming!

All Saints Day falls on Tue. Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> this year. Mass times are as follows:

**Holy Day Mass:** at 7 a.m. at St. Ann Church on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>;

**Holy Day Mass:** at 5:30 p.m. at St. Vincent de Paul Church, also on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>.

**All Souls Day** will be observed this year on Wednesday, Nov. 2 with our regular 7 a.m. Mass. On this day we commemorate all of the faithful departed. All are welcome.

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed following 7 a.m. Mass and conclude with Benediction at noon. ### UNDERSTANDING THE REVISED MASS TEXTS

In the pews of each of our three parishes you will find a booklet written by Paul Turner, a priest of the diocese of Kansas City – St. Joseph. This booklet provides a brief yet deep explanation of how and why the prayers and responses of the Mass are changing. This resource will help you understand the importance and meaning of the new words we hear and say at Mass, the rationale and process for translating the prayers of the Mass from Latin into English, the significance of the translation in relation to the parts of the Mass, and how deeply the Mass is rooted in scripture. Understanding the Revised Mass Texts, Second Edition will help you understand the new words so that you will be able to participate at Mass when the translation is implemented in Advent 2011. Please feel free to take a copy home with you.

**END OF LIFE PANEL DISCUSSION:** This November, St. Ann will offer an opportunity to explore “end of life decisions” that we all must face. A panel discussion with **Ned Roche**, director of Roche Funeral Home, **Rich Hayes**, Chaplin for Hospice, **Deb Kuni**, St. Ann Cemetery’s Administrative Assistant, and **Father C.J. Waitekus**, pastor of St. Ann, St. Patrick and St. Vincent de Paul parishes, will address the details of planning a funeral, Mass, burial and the emotions surrounding the loss of a loved one. Please consider attending one of the 2 free presentations on **Nov. 8th at 7 p.m. and Nov. 15th at 2 p.m. both in St. Ann’s Family Center**. This event is free and open to the public. No registration is required. Light refreshments will be served.

There will be a reception celebrating Father C.J.’s anniversary on Thursday, Nov. 10, from 5 to 7 p.m. in the Family Center. The reception is open to our three parishes and their guests.
