Historical Notes

The first St. Ann Church was built on Main Street in 1870, paid for by donations of both Catholics and non-Catholics. It was a wooden frame church in the Gothic Revival style.

The present St. Ann Church was constructed in 1911-12. It was built in an early English Norman style at a cost of \$100,000. The church was designed by architect F. Burrell Hoffman of New York and built by the E.L. Sampson Brothers of Springfield.

The pulpit was given by Charles Astor Bristed, Jr. The main altar was the gift of Rev. William F. Grace, and was consecrated in October, 1918.

In 1931 parishioners were invited to bring in field stones from which the Lourdes Shrine in the lot south of the church was constructed.
