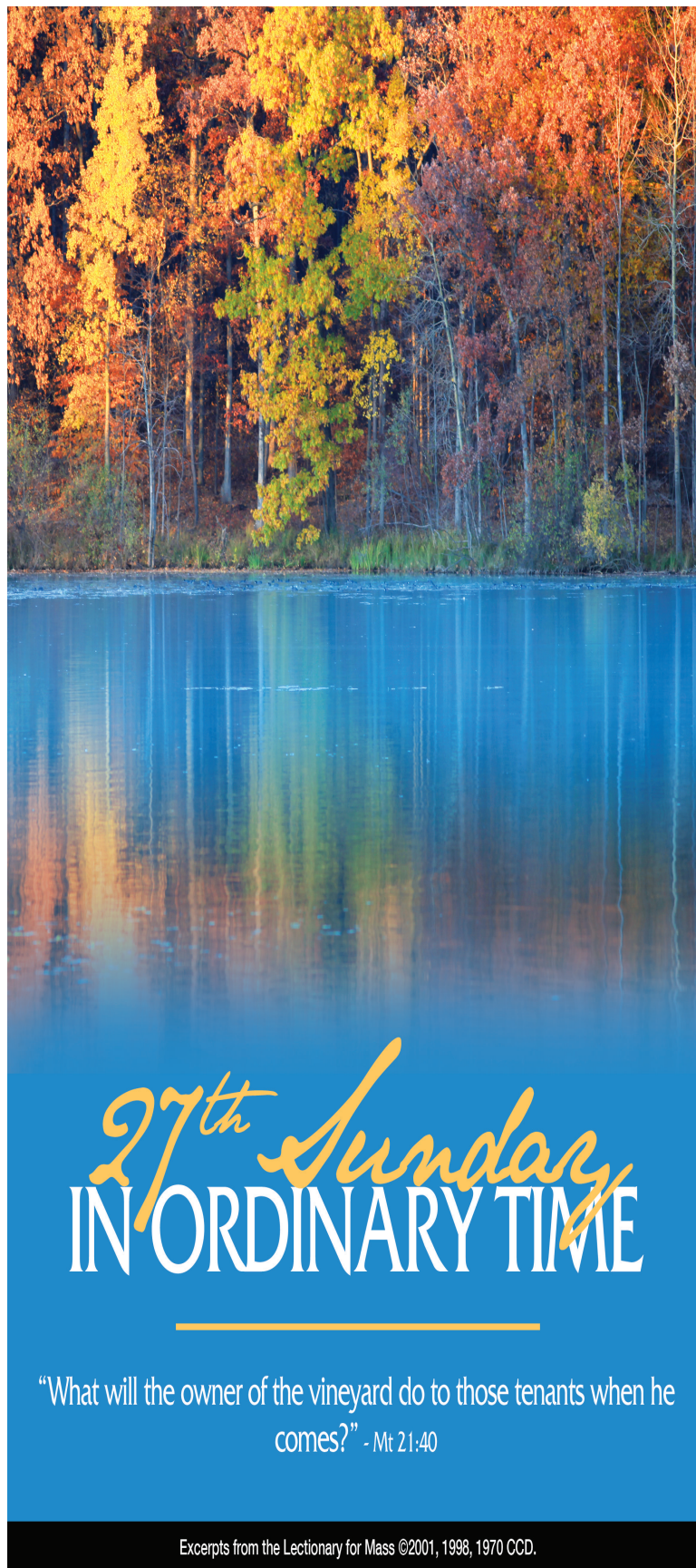

Five hundred years after the start of the Reformation, local Catholics and Lutherans, joined by members of the extended interfaith community, will gather together to mark this pivotal moment in history, along with celebrating the last 50 years of positive Lutheran/Catholic dialogue.

As a sign of the growing ties between these faith communities, a joint Lutheran-Catholic prayer service led by Springfield Roman Catholic Bishop Mitchell T. Rozanski and Pastor Lauren Holm of the Bethesda Lutheran Church in Springfield will be held to commemorate the Reformation on Sunday, Oct. 29 at 2 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral in Springfield.
