

VIOLENCE AND THE SACRED A LENTEN SERIES WITH MSGR. JOHN

Join Msgr. John in our Family Center for a Lenten series, Violence and the Sacred. The series began Thu. Feb. 22, and will run each Thursday during Lent, from 6:30 to 8 p.m.

Violence and religion have been linked for as far back as we can see. What is the link between the two? Where does violence spring from in the human heart? Why does God seem to need sacrifice? How did Jesus change that dynamic? We will examine a theory of violence and violence in the bible and trace how sacred violence has evolved from the old testament to the new testament. We will pay particular attention to the passion of Jesus.

No need to pre-register. All are welcome.

Lent is typically a time when Catholics think about what to "give up". This year we invite all of our parishioners to sign up and "DO something" instead. You are being challenged to perform Random Acts of Kindness (ARK). There is a fund set aside which will be divided among those volunteers that will and have already signed up to participate in this project. With the money that you will receive, you are commissioned to use it for the good of others. Whether it is buying coffee for someone in line behind you or buying ingredients to bake cookies for someone, it has to be used for the good of others and the possibilities are endless.
