Short Excerpts Taken from *Pope Francis Speaks to Families Words of Joy and Life*

A New Mission Field

The Christian family, in fact, is the first community called to announce the Gospel to the human person during growth and to bring him or her, through education and catechesis, to full human and Christian maturity" (Familiars Consortio, 2). Marital fidelity is above all the foundation upon which a harmonious family life can be built. Unfortunately, in our time we see that the family and marriage are undergoing a deep inner crisis in the countries of the Western world... Globalization and postmodern individualism promote a lifestyle that makes it much more difficult to develop stable bonds between people, and it is not conductive to promoting a culture of the family.

This opens up a new mission field for the Church; for example, among groups of families where opportunities are created for interpersonal relationships and for a relationship with God, where authentic communion that welcomes everyone equally can grow, that does not close itself off into groups of the elite, that heals wounds, builds bridges, goes in search of the lost, and helps "to bear one another's burdens" (Galatians 6:2).

This excerpt was taken from the book, "*Pope Francis Speaks to Families* Words of Joy and Life" by the Word Among Us.

WARNING

The diocese is again receiving reports of an attempt to trick parishioners into sending money via gift cards under the guise of responding to a fake request from parish priests.

Somehow they get parishioner cell phone numbers and/or email addresses. Posing as me or other parish priests they are able to trick folks into sending them funds usually via a gift card which the scammers ask parishioners to buy and then send them the gift card number and pin, which is all the scammers need to cash them in, leaving the unsuspected parishioner out of luck. In almost all cases the money is not recoverable.

Please rest assured that I will NEVER solicit funds via text messages or emails – nor funds that involve gift cards, and that if you should receive any type of communication that seems suspicious you should report it to local police and the parish office. Anyone asking for help via a gift card of any type should be viewed as suspicious.
