

Short Excerpts Taken from Pope Francis Speaks to Families Words of Joy and Life

A Mother Knows How To Balance Things

A mother . . . thinks of the health of her children, teaching them also to face the difficulties of life. You do not teach, do not take care of health by avoiding problems, as though life were a motorway with no obstacles. The mother helps her children to see the problems of life realistically and not to get lost in them, but to confront them with courage; not to be weak, and to know how to overcome them, in a healthy balance that a mother "senses" between the area of security and the area of risk. And a mother can do this! She does not always take the child along the safe road, because in that way the child cannot develop, but neither does she leave the child only on the risky path, because that is dangerous. A mother knows how to balance things. A life without challenges does not exist, and a boy or a girls who cannot face or tackle them is a boy or a girl with no backbone!


WeShare — Our Online Giving Program
