



Short Excerpts Taken from *Pope Francis Speaks to Families Words of Joy and Life*

Do We "Waste Time" with Children?

We have to ask ourselves: who are we, as we stand before the Child Jesus? Who are we, standing as we stand before today's children? Are we like Mary and Joseph, who welcomed Jesus and cared for him with the love of a father and a mother? Or are we like Herod, who wanted to eliminate him? Are we like the shepherds, who went in haste to kneel before him in worship and offer him their humble gifts? Or are we indifferent? Are we, perhaps, people who use fine and pious words, yet exploit pictures of poor children in order to make money? Are we ready to be there for children, to "waste time" with them? Are we ready to listen to them, to care for them, to pray for them and with them? Or do we ignore them because we are too caught up in our own affairs?

Presenters will be Dr. Emily Clionsky board certified neuropsychiatrist and internal medicine doctor, specializing in dementia and conditions that lead to dementia, and Dr. Mitchell Clionsky, board certified clinical neuropsychologist, specializing in the assessment of memory disorders, mild traumatic brain injury and ADD. The talk will include a brief diagnostic test, the data collected will be used to conduct scientific research to develop new cognitive testing. Participants will receive a \$10 gift card for themselves, or can choose to instead have an equivalent donation made to the Parish.
