The communion of life embraced by spouses, their openness to the gift of life, the mutual protection, the encounter and the memory of generations, educational support, the transmission of the Christian father to their children . . . With all this the family continues to be a school unparalleled in humanity, an indispensable contribution to a just and supportive society (cf. *Evangelii Gaudium*, 66-68). And the deeper its roots, the more possible it is in life to go out and go far, without getting lost or feeling a stranger in a foreign land.




