The diocese is again receiving reports of an attempt to trick parishioners into sending money via gift cards under the guise of responding to a fake request from parish priests.

Somehow they get parishioner cell phone numbers and/or email addresses. Posing as me or other parish priests, they are able to trick folks into sending them funds usually via a gift card which the scammers ask parishioners to buy and then send them the gift card number and pin, which is all the scammers need to cash them in, leaving the unsuspected parishioner out of luck. In almost all cases the money is not recoverable.

Please rest assured that I will NEVER solicit funds via text messages or emails – nor funds that involve gift cards, and that if you should receive any type of communication that seems suspicious you should report it to local police. Anyone asking for help via a gift card of any type should be viewed as suspicious.

Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for your continued support. This letter is for the purpose of information. Most of our babies outgrow sizes 1-3 diapers very quickly. By 6 months, many (especially those who nurse) are in bigger sizes, some even in sizes 5 and 6. They also outgrow the smaller sizes of clothing quickly, and are into 18 month, 24 month (2T), and even 3T and 4T much sooner than you would expect. We distribute diapers from preemie and newborn up to size 6. The sizes seem to imply age, but are actually determined by weight. Some babies the same age wear different size diapers, and it is not unusual for different-age siblings to wear the same size. We also distribute pull-ups for children who are being potty-trained (sizes 2T -3T, 3T-4T, and 4T-5T, again related to weight not age); and clothing up to size 7. Also, many of our families do not have cars, so strollers are a necessity. Thank you all again.
