The Gift of Wisdom

Think of a mother at her home with the children; when one does something, the other thinks of something else, and the poor mother goes to and fro with the problems of her children. And when mothers get tired and scold the children, is that wisdom? Scolding children—I ask you—is this wisdom? What do you say: is it wisdom or not? No!

Instead, when the mother takes her child aside and gently reproves him, saying, "Don't do this, because. . . ," and explains with great patience, is this the wisdom of God? Yes! It is what the Holy Spirit gives us in life! Then, in marriage, for example, the two spouses—the husband and wife—argue, and then they don't look at each other, or if they do look at each other, they look at each other with displeasure: is this the wisdom of God? No! Instead, if one says, "Ah well, the storm has passed, let's make peace," and they begin again and go forward in peace: is this wisdom? . . . Now, this is the gift of wisdom. May it come to our homes; may we have it with the children; may it come to us all!




