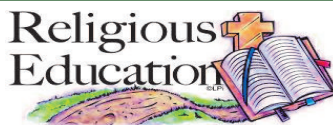

Along the way we will trace the development of beliefs, heresies, monasticism, models of organization, and politics (theirs, not ours). We will also meet a variety of characters.

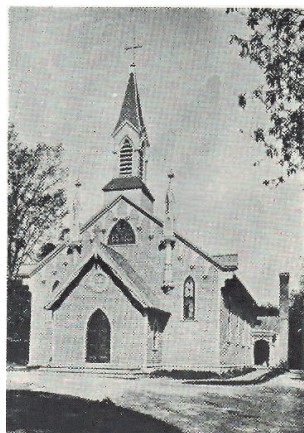
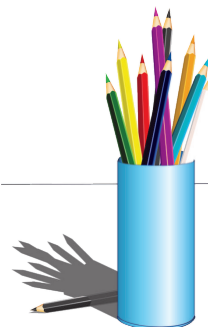

### Lenten Music Series

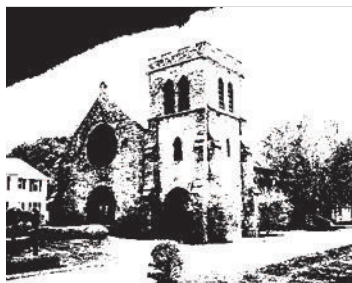

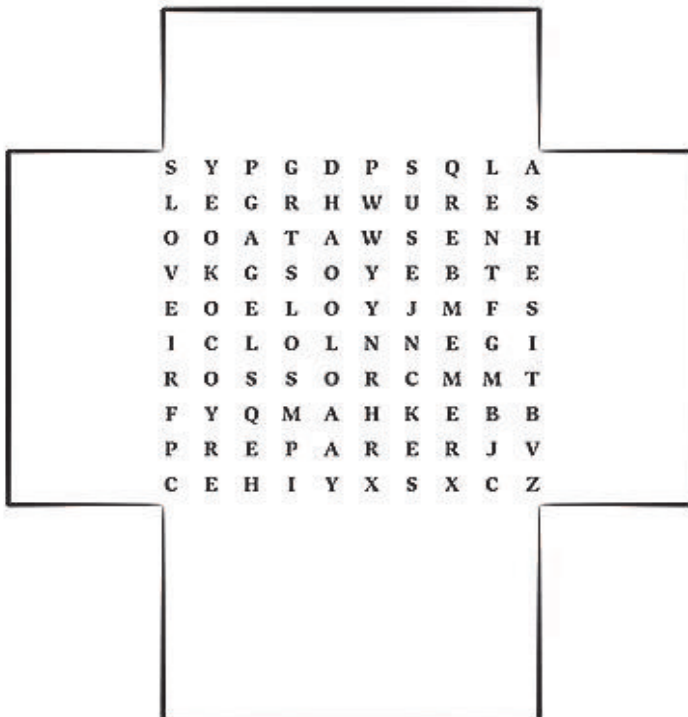
