

Yes! We're open, but..... As most of you have heard, St. Ann, St. Vincent de Paul and St. Patrick parishes are all open again. We have unlocked the familiar doors to our church buildings, but what our Masses will look like are very different than the last time you payed us a visit.

The first change is the limited number of persons that will be allowed at each Mass. 50. That's it. If you would like to join us for Mass on the weekend, you <u>MUST</u> first make a reservations so that we know who and how many people will be at each Mass. Once that magic number has been reached, we will not be allowing anyone else in for that Mass. Reservations for any parish, any Mass time, for right now, can be made by calling Debbie at St. Ann's Rectory at 637-0157, <u>Monday through Thursday</u>— no later than by 2 p.m. on Thursday.

The next important thing you need to know is that you will be required to wear a mask during Mass. St. Ann's has a few on hand if you forget yours, but please try to remember to bring one.

St. Vincent de Paul has decided to celebrate their 5:30 Saturday Mass at St. Ann's Church instead of their Lenox Dale location. That Mass will be open to all parishioners of our three Masses.

We will not be taking up collections the same way as before. You will find baskets at the entrances of the church that will be available to you to place your donation either on the way into the church or as you leave. (We appreciate and thank you for your continued financial support through all of the weeks that we were shut down.) If you are with us from one of the other parishes, you can use your own church envelope or make your check payable to that specific church. We will return them to each parish.

You will be asked to remain in your pew throughout the entire Mass. Our pastor and deacons will come to you with communion. Communion will be received in hand only.

One last note of interest: We are asking people to leave right after Mass so that we have time to clean the church before the next Mass begins.
