If you are attending from one of our other parishes, we will forward your donation to the appropriate church. **Your check should be made payable to your own parish.** There will be no collection taken up during Mass until all state and diocesan restrictions are lifted. We appreciate your continued support during this difficult time.

MASS BOOK

If you have put off booking Masses for this year or next, this is a perfect time to call the office and book those Masses for your loved ones. We have a good selection of Sunday and Saturday Masses available in 2020, as well as week days. We also have our 2021 book if you want to book ahead. We can also reserve the Sanctuary Candle if you'd like. Call or email our office and feel free to leave a message if the office is closed.

Yes! We're open, but..... As most of you have heard, St. Ann, St. Vincent de Paul and St. Patrick parishes are all open again. We have unlocked the familiar doors to our church buildings, but what our Masses will look like are very different than the last time you payed us a visit.

The first change is the limited number of persons that will be allowed at each Mass. 50. That's it. If you would like to join us for Mass on the weekend, you **MUST** first make a reservations so that we know who, and how many people, will be at each Mass. You can register by going to our website, Stannlenox.org. Once that magic number has been reached, we will not be allowing anyone else in for that Mass for that weekend. Reservations for any parish, any Mass time, for right now, can also be made by calling Debbie at St. Ann's Rectory at 637-0157, **Monday through Thursday— no later than by 2 p.m. on Thursday.** The office is closed Friday afternoons so don't put off registering before then.

The next important thing you need to know is that you will be required to wear a mask during Mass. St. Ann's has a few on hand if you forget yours, but please try to remember to bring one.

St. Vincent de Paul parish will be returning to the Dale for their 5:30 Saturday Mass, starting this weekend.

St. Patrick's Sunday morning Mass will return to their usual 8:30 time beginning this weekend.

We will not be taking up collections the same way as before. You will find baskets at the entrances of the church that will be available to you to place your donation either on the way into the church or as you leave. (We appreciate and thank you for your continued financial support through all of the weeks that we were shut down.) If you are with us from one of the other parishes, you can use your own church envelope or make your check payable to that specific church. We will return them to each parish.

You will be asked to remain in your pew throughout the entire Mass. Our pastor or a Eucharistic Minister will come to you with communion. Communion will be received in hand only.

One last note of interest: We are asking people to leave right after Mass so that we have time to clean the church before the next Mass begins. If you are willing to help sanitize the church following Mass, just remain after Mass.

We have also resumed our 7 a.m. Morning Mass. These daily Masses are being held in our church building.
